You could either use real 1p coins, print and cut out the coins below or make your own.

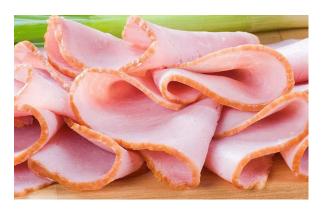
You could make up all sorts of other problems too. Why not have a go at writing out the number sentences too! eg. 5p + 2p = 7p

Once they have got the hang of adding values together, have a go the next activity which is taking away from 10p. Enjoy!





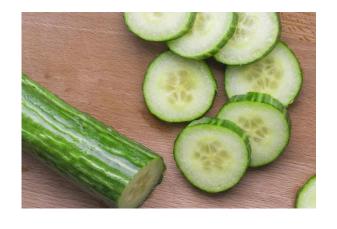
If a ham costs 5p and tomato costs 3p, how much money will you spend? Use the coins to help.
