# Fire, fire!

This week we have been busy learning all about the fire service and fire safety. The children have become very aware of how dangerous fire can be and show a sound understanding of how fire can escalate from the smallest spark.

They have loved retelling The Gingerbread Man story and, this week, we have also had a go at changing the main character, which was fun. The children have thoroughly enjoyed making their own gingerbread men with playdough, flavoured with spices, and decorating them with real buttons, sultanas and sprigs of rosemary.

In Maths the children have continued to work on developing their 'sorting' skills and understanding the concept of the number 2. They are mastering the ability to count on and back to and from 2, identifying arrays, understanding that the amount of objects doesn't change (even if you move them) unless you add more or take some away.
