Remote Education Provision - Years 5 and 6

From the 11th January, 2020, Year 5/6 will be moving to a new remote learning programme for children who are not in school. Please read the following information carefully:

Check in

Twice daily, your child will be able to access a fifteen minute 'check in' with their class teacher to discuss the day ahead and review their day's work. Check ins will take place through Microsoft Teams. Invitations for daily check ins will be sent to the email address on the school's system. Please ensure you are checking your emails on a regular basis. You do not need to register for Teams, you can enter the meeting as a guest from various platforms (Laptop, Mobile Phone, Tablet etc).

These will occur at the following times:

Start of the day

Y5- 8:45am

Y6- 9am

Y3- 9:15am

Y4-9:30am

End of the day

Y5-2:30pm

Y6 - 2:45pm

Y3 - 3pm

Y4 - 3:15pm.

English and Maths Lessons

Your child's work will be available on Purple Mash on a daily basis. A resource sheet will be available which children can add answers and write paragraphs onto. There may also be additional resources such as PowerPoints, videos and audio files to assist them with their learning. Please note that this work will only be available for a 48 hour period to avoid confusion if work is missed. More work will be available the following day. Purple Mash can be accessed through a range of digital devices such as tablets, laptops and mobile phones.

Topic

Your child will be able to access a range of weekly topic learning materials. These will change on a weekly basis for example, the first week may have an art focus and the following a music focus. We will also be sending children suggestions for keeping active and challenges for them to complete in PE.

Suggested Timetable.

Over the course of the day, we recommend your child spend 4 hours on their learning. As well as daily lessons for English, maths and topic, please see the suggested activities which your child could also complete. We recognise that accessing these activities at certain times can be tricky, especially if there are multiple children within a household, so please do your very best.

English = 1 hour 20 mins (daily work, reading, spelling shed, lexia, reading plus)

Maths = 1 hour 20 mins (daily work, TT Rockstars, hit the Button)

Topic = 50 mins

Check in = 30 minutes.
