

# Let's get planting!

It's been another busy week of investigating in Foundation Stage. We started the week off by experimenting with what plants need to survive. We found out that the cress seeds we planted grew much better in soil than they did on cotton wool. Plants also need a lot of light and water to grow well. We drew pictures of what they need and tried to label them too.



Our gardening day was a great success! In the morning the children worked so hard at digging out any weeds, moving old plants to other areas and getting the beds ready for planting.
