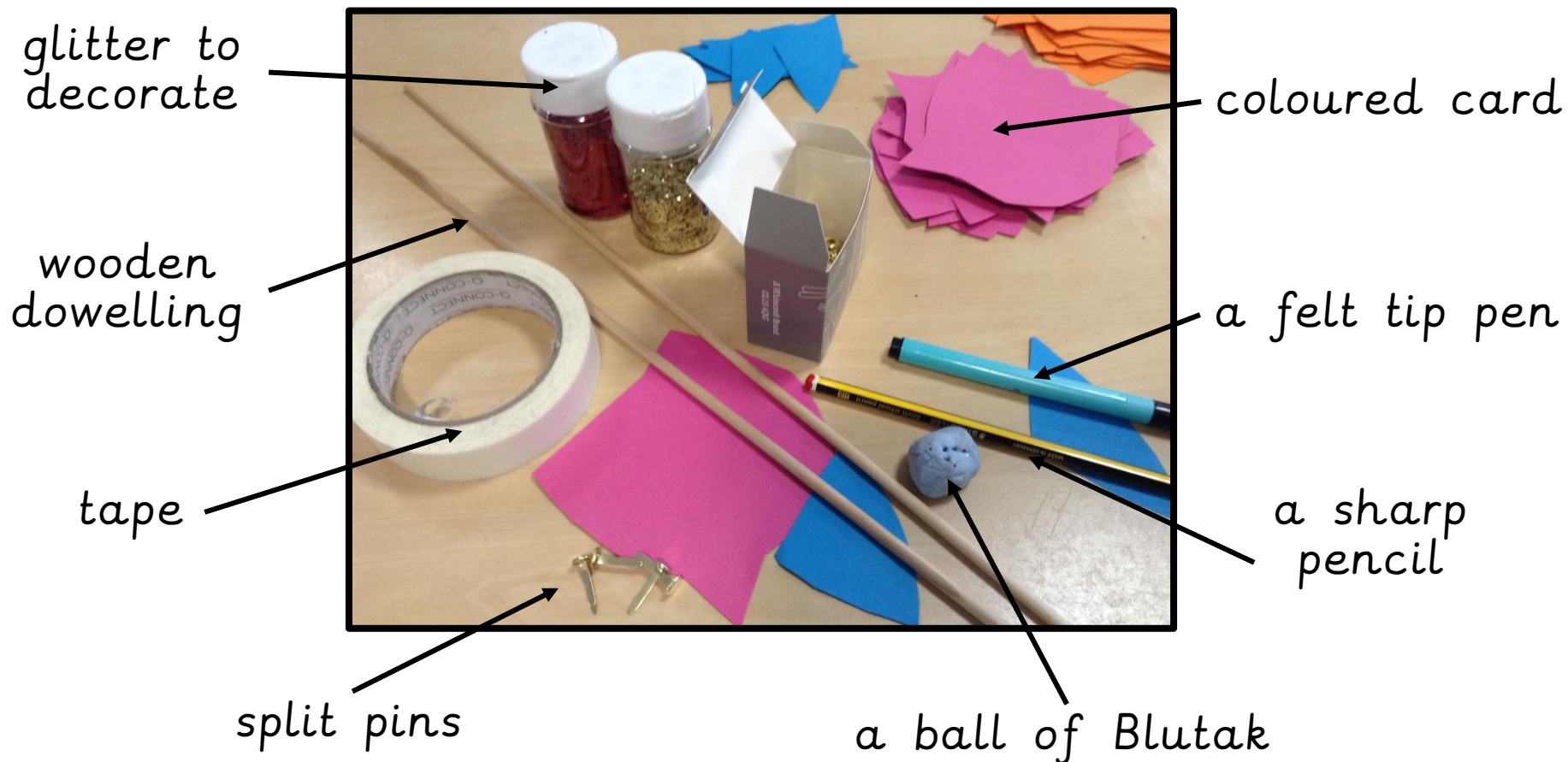


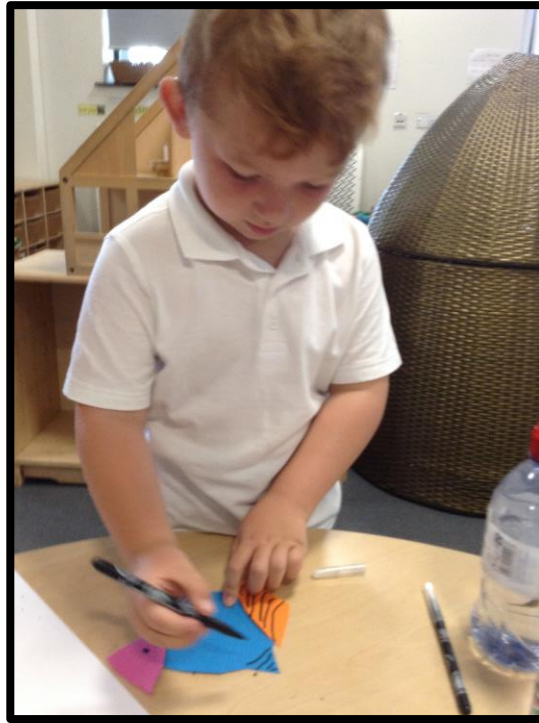
F2 make
moving puppets!



Today we looked at how we could make a puppet that we could move. It was VERY exciting! We decided that we would make fish!

We found all the materials that we would need...





First of all we had to choose which coloured card we would like to make our fish.

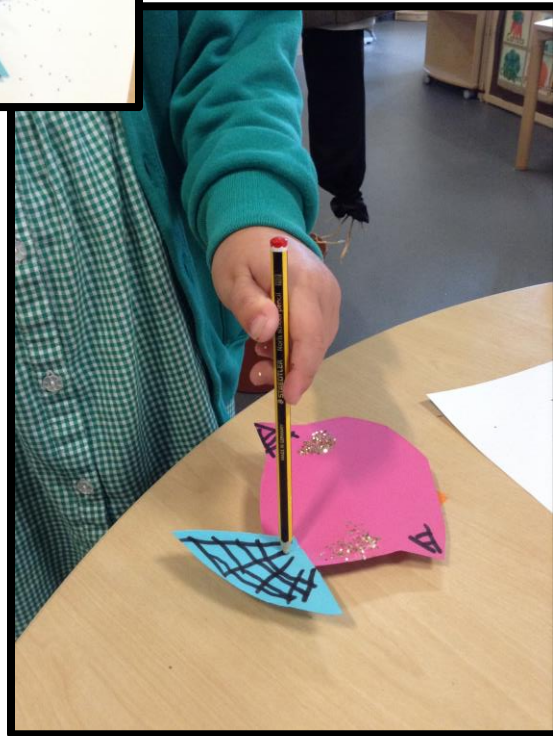
Then we had to use the black felt tip to draw an eye on its face and patterns on its fins and tail.

Next we decorated its body with glitter.

That was the easy bit done!

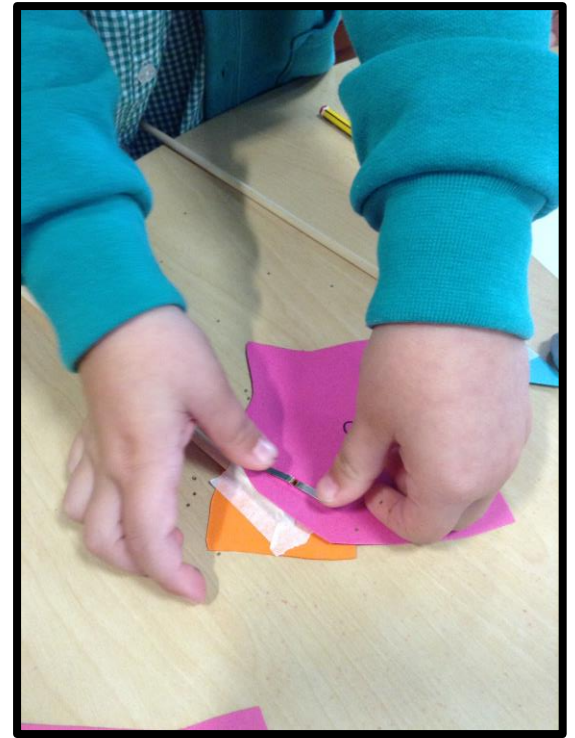


Our next job was to use the sharp pencil to make holes in our pieces of card. We put the Blutak underneath and pressed the point all the way through. We had to really use our muscles for it to work!





Then the head and tail of the fish needed a long piece of wooden dowel fixing to it. We decided that tape was the easiest thing to use but we still had to make sure that it was stuck on really well.



Next we had to push a split pin through the holes we had made to attach the fish's head and tail to its body. It was quite tricky to do.

We then had to carefully open up the back of the split pin so that everything would stay fixed together but still move.

The results were fantastic...
