We've had such a busy week this week. We have started our 'Celebrations' topic, and our first celebration has been bonfire night. The children have learnt all about why we celebrate bonfire night and how it all started. We know all about Guy Fawkes and the Gunpowder Plot.

We made bonfire and firework pictures. We built pretend bonfires. We made a model of the Houses of Parliament out of the outdoor large construction equipment. We also learnt the famous poem about November the 5th. Why not ask your children if they can *remember* it?
