We all loved being able to touch the animals.

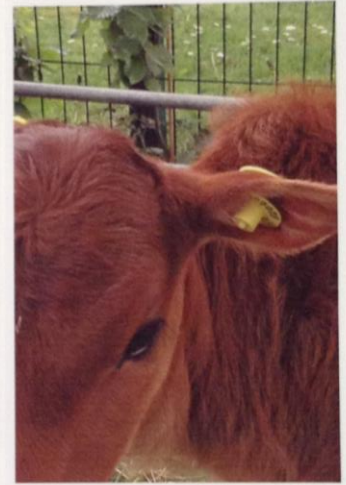
Aaliyah: It's a bit prickly!
