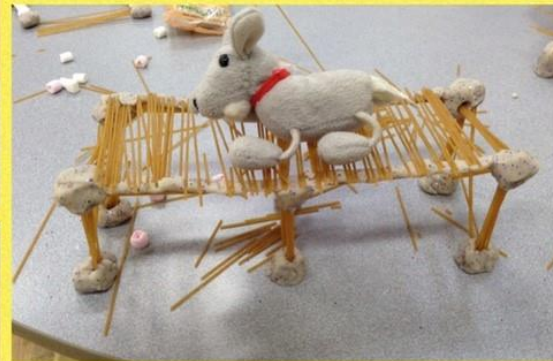
We made bridges using bricks and planks. We had to be very careful to balance the planks on the bricks. Can you spot any trolls?
