On Monday we watched the year 6 children perform their end of year play. It was really funny and the singing was fabulous.

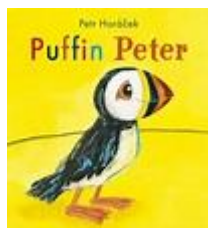
