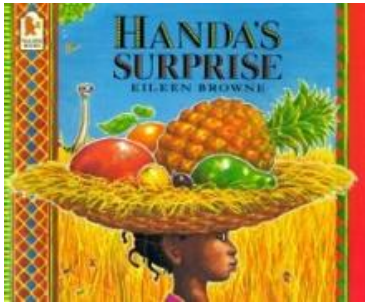


# Home School Diary
