This week in FI...

This week in FI we have been learning all about the story 'It was a cold, dark night'. It is all about a hedgehog trying to find a home.

In Maths this week we have been singing the song 1,2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive. We have also been learning a hedgehog rhyme about 5 hedgehogs. The children have been using quantities of 1 to 3 and taking it in turns to count how many objects using a giant 5 frame.

On our 'I Wonder Wednesday' the children had lots of fun making chocolate cornflake crispy hedgehog buns. We discussed how we needed to melt the chocolate first and then mix the ingredients together before putting the mixture into bun cases. We then used raisins for the hedgehog's eyes and a dried cranberry for the nose.
