

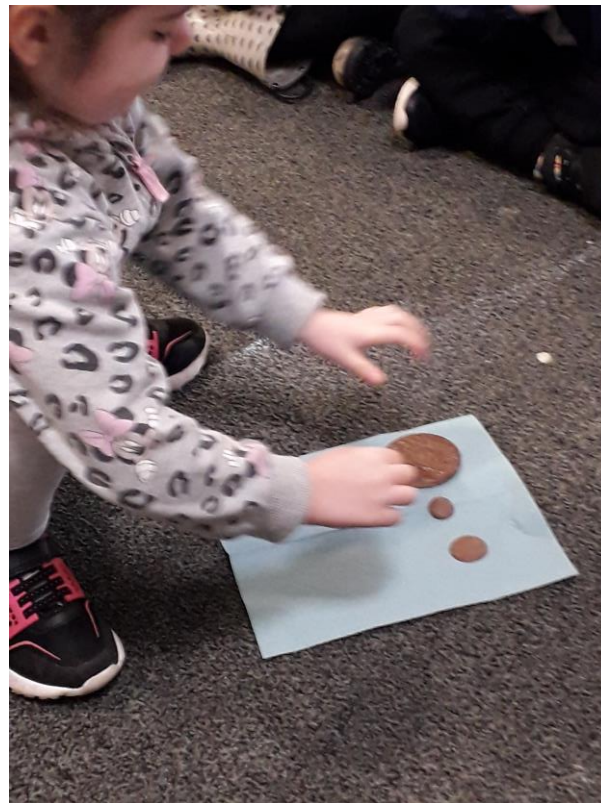
Making Bear Biscuits
