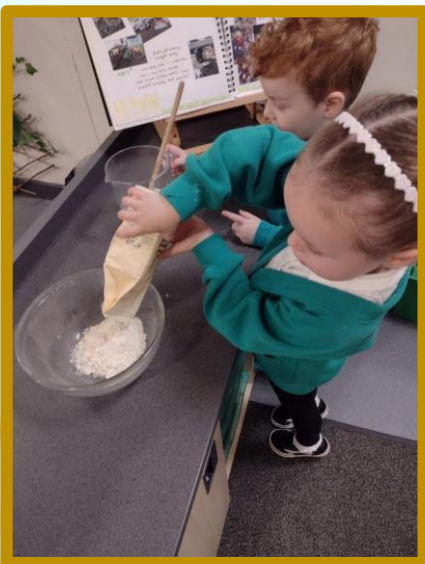

Once all the dough was shaped, Ivy C. told us, "We need to cook it." She was right.

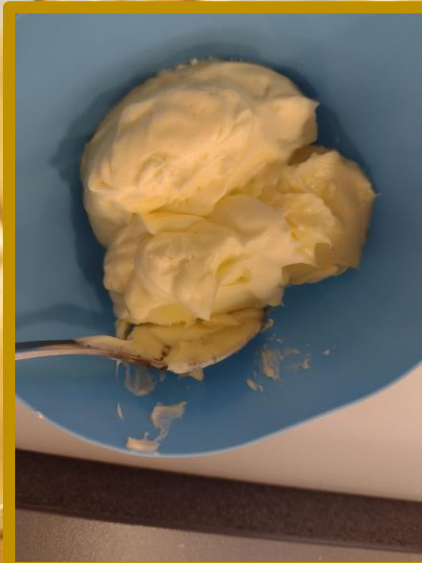
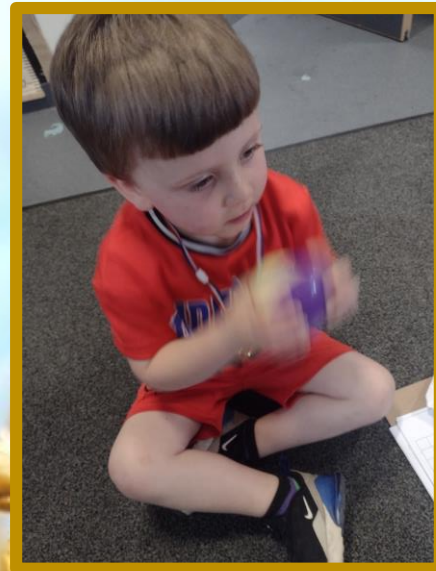
So Mrs Silverwood carefully put the bread dough into the hot oven. Some of us loved watching the timer, on the board, count down until the alarm went off.

When the bread was ready it was a lovely, golden-brown colour.





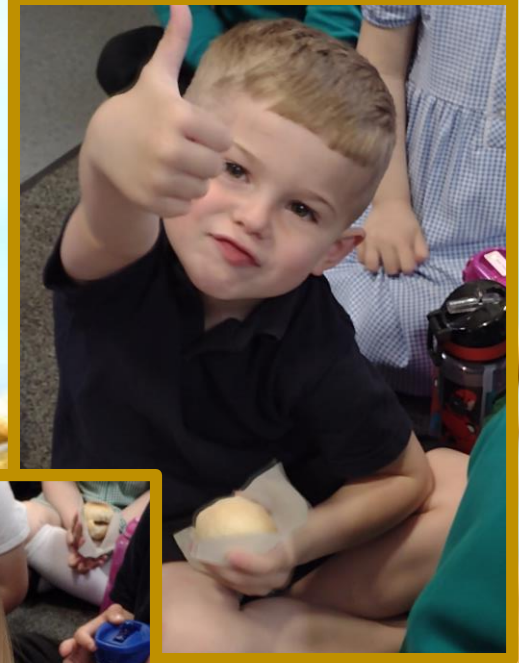
We thought
