Harvey : The leaves are falling off the trees. The wind keeps blowing them off.

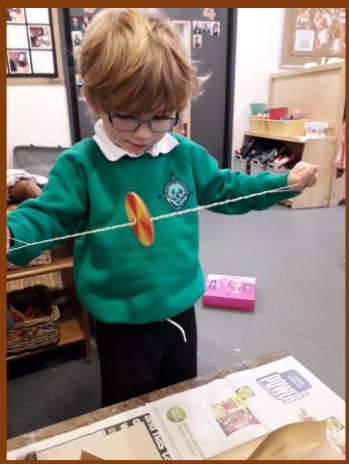
Amelia : (The leaves are...) Dead. Brown.
