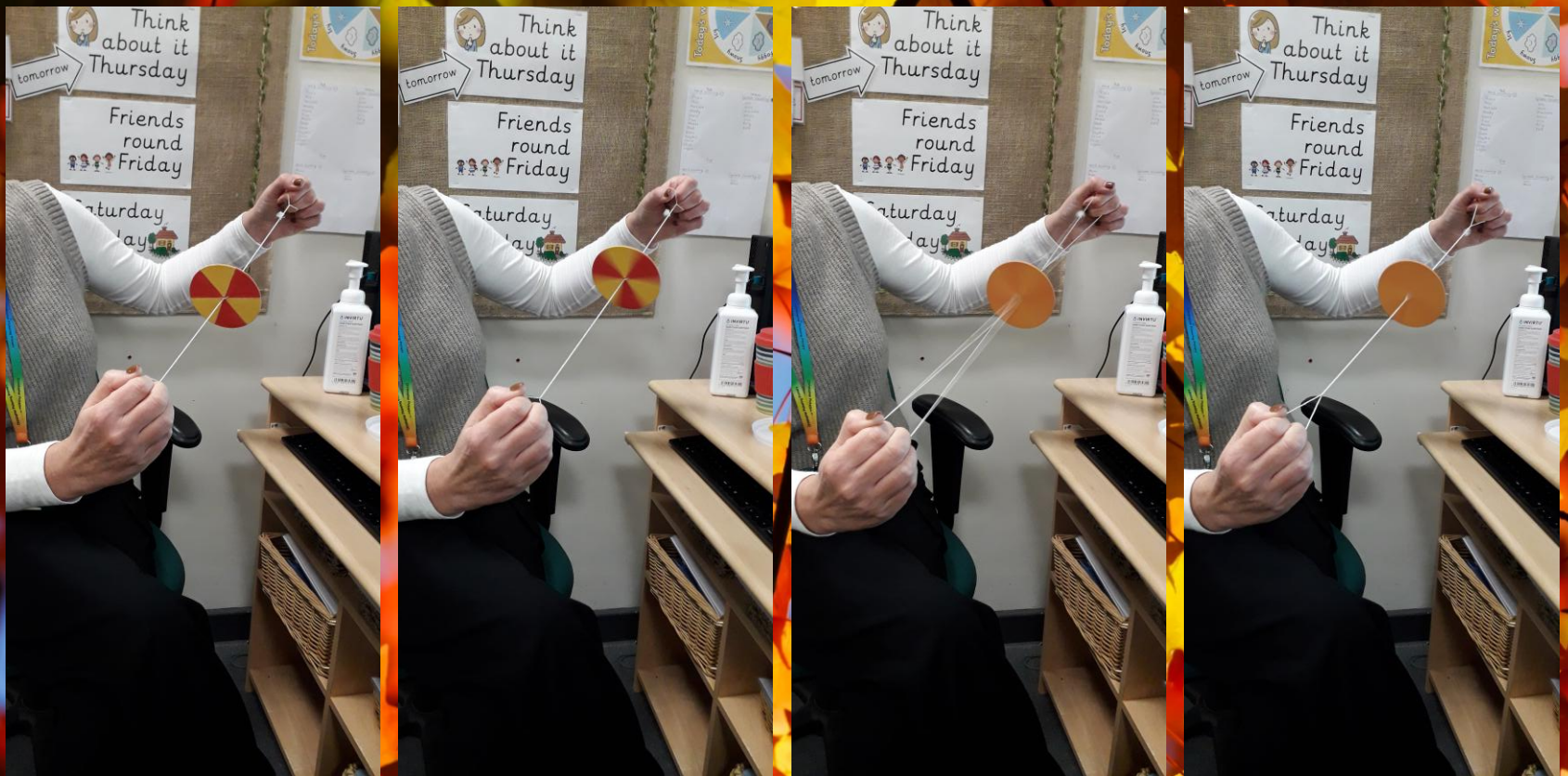
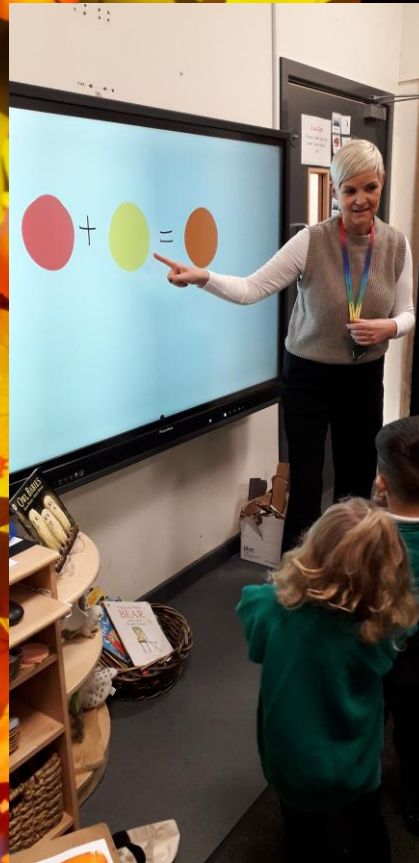




*Autumn
