

London's Calling

Year 2 Spring Term



As WRITERS we will be studying the story 'The King Who Banned the Dark' and writing our own stories, letters, diary entries and descriptions based on the story. We will also be writing letters to King Charles III. We will then be walking to the post box to post these and we hope he replies! As READERS we will be reading 'The Tunnel'.

As HISTORIANS we will be learning about The Great Fire of London. We will look at the cause and effects of the fire and how London changed after the fire. We will also be learning about the monarchy.

As GEOGRAPHERS we will be learning about human and physical features of London. We will be learning the difference between a city, town and a village.

In COMPUTING— we will be learning about programming. We will then learn how to use pictograms.

As ARTISTS we will be using our sketching skills to draw a variety of portraits. We will also study the artist Julian Opie. As DESIGNERS we will be designing, making and evaluating our own royal carriages.

In P.E— we will developing our gymnastic skills in our indoor session. In our outdoor session, we will be developing our dribbling skills to keep possession of the ball.

As SCIENTISTS we will learning about materials. We will be looking at the properties of different materials. We will use this knowledge to think about whether materials are suitable or unsuitable for different purposes.

As MATHEMATICIANS we will be learning about Money. We will learn to count in pounds and pence, make different amounts and find change. We will then be learning about Multiplication and Division. We will learn to apply our knowledge of counting in 2s, 10s and 5s to solve multiplication and division problems. Later in the term, we will be learning to use different measurements.

In RE—we will be exploring the question 'What is believing'? In Personal Development—we will be learning about Dreams and Goals.
