<u>General:</u>

Year 6 children will receive their revision guides, and it will be expected for your child to work through these packs at home. These will provide valuable support for your child in the lead-up to SATs and they will replace their previous homework sheets. Your child can also access their TT Rockstars accounts at home to give them extra times tables practice. You do not need to buy this app as it can be accessed directly from the internet.
