Curriculum Information

Reading

We are glad to see that the children are enjoying their reading for pleasure books that they take home. The children love coming to get their 'library' books. Please remember to return them each week, so your child can get a new one. Even if it's the same one. Children love to hear the same story over and over. It helps embed their story language, as well as provide familiarity and comfort for them.

Some children in F2 are now coming home with a Ditty sheet. Please try to read this on the evening it comes home. This again will support the children in developing their reading skills and build on the work they have done at school. Don't worry if they haven't got one yet... they will soon.

Physical development and independence

This term we will be encouraging the children to become more independent. We are focusing on putting their coats on and being able to fasten their coats, putting on their gloves and looking after their own property. Please try to practice this at home, especially fastening their coats.

Keeping warm

Please remember that the children are outside, sometimes for an hour at a time. If possible, please send warm coats, a hat, scarf and gloves. Please label them with your child's name.
