Year 1 Autumn Term



As **WRITERS** we will be focussing on key skills such as writing simple sentences with punctuation. We will be exploring the stories 'Where the Wild Things Are' and 'Little Red Riding Hood'. Our non-fiction topics include labels and captions, poetry and instructions. As **READERS** we will continue to learn new phonic sounds and build on our reading fluency.

As **HISTORIANS** we will be looking at our local area of Hull and how it has changed over the years. We will particularly look at the 60's era and compare it to today.

As **GEOGRAPHERS** we will be looking at what is a human and physical feature. We will explore this by walking around the school groups and plotting our findings on a ariel map.

In **COMPUTING**— we will be exploring what technology is and safe ways of using it.

As **ARTISTS** we will be studying the works of David Hockney and bringing his work to life, drawing inspiration from our local area.

As **DESIGNERS**—we will be designing and creating freestanding structures.

In **RE**—we will be discovering symbolism. In **Jigsaw**—we will be focusing on 'Being Me in My World' and 'Celebrating Differences'.

As **SCIENTISTS** we will be learning about animals including humans. This will involve labelling the human body, exploring our 5 senses and comparing our human features to those of animals. We will also be looking at autumn weather and the changes that will happen this season.

As **MATHEMATICIANS**—we will be deepening our understanding of numbers up to 10 within our place value unit. We will then explore addition and subtraction and finally shapes.

In **P.E**— both our units will include ball skills and dance. We will focus on throwing and catching and agility.
