When we tried to remember what they were called, Ewura said, “oats”! Great work Ewura!

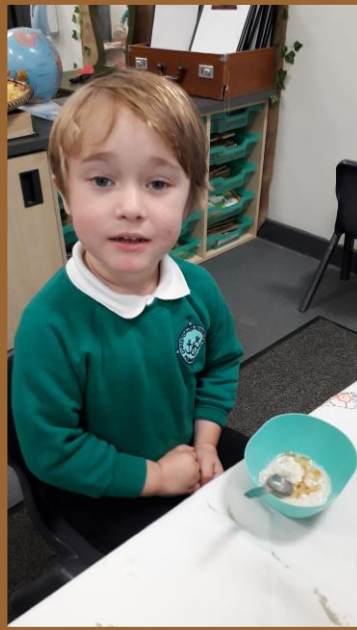


Parker measured out the milk and Ewura measured out the water. Cally said we need the wooden spoon to,
