Dear Parents


World Book Day will take place on **Friday 12 March** in school and we would like you to help us encourage your child to make the most of this special occasion.

The day provides an opportunity to celebrate the joy and value of books and reading. To help get them started on their reading journey, every child receives a £1 World Book Day Token. Book tokens will be sent home with your child on Monday 8 March and can be exchanged for one of ten £1 World Book Day books available at participating bookshops.
