To enhance Year 8's understanding of Britain's role in the Empire and students to engage further with our topic Slavery, a trip to M Shed in Bristol has been organised. There will be an opportunity for the students to explore the M-Shed museum as well as taking part in a workshop.

During the workshop, students will investigate objects and historic documents to explore peoples' attitudes towards the slave trade and how Bristol was changed by its involvement.

Students will:

- Interrogate source materials
- Take part in a discussion about what the people of Bristol believed about the Transatlantic Slave Trade
- Investigate four themes relating to the divisions caused by the Transatlantic Slave Trade:
- 1. Shipping and trade
- 2. The plantations
- 3. Profit
- 4. The abolition campaign

We will be leaving Court Fields School at 8:40 to allow for students getting to school on a coach and will be returning before 3:15.
