Despite the challenges of Covid, it's been a busy time at school with our charity support and highlighting local and national events. Anti-Bullying Week took place throughout last week. Students spent time in Tutor Periods and PSHCE lessons developing their understanding of bullying, its impact and how to support others. 
Year 11 Exams & Temporary Changes to School Lunch Times

All other times will remain the same. We will return to the usual lunch timings on our return to School in January.






Students must wear face masks at all times on school transport.
