Your child will also bring home an EV5 form for this week. This form MUST be completed and returned to their tutor by Wednesday 16th June 2021. I include below a **kit list**. All specialist equipment will be provided however the following items should be considered when packing:

- Sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Torch
- Warm clothes (Fleece/jumper/hoodie (it can be quite cool after sunset))
- Waterproof jacket or cagoule
- Dry trainers
- Wet trainers old ones! (all activities both wet and dry require **closed-toe footwear**)
- Pyjamas or sleepwear
- Towels (1 for showering and 1-2 smaller ones for wet sports)
- Toiletries
- Swimming shorts (with liner)
- Swimming costume(s)
- Old Shorts (quick-drying is better)
- Sufficient changes of underwear!
- Sun hat
- Water-resistant sunscreen (essential)
- Spare bin liner
- A large water bottle (essential)
- Any **medication** your child needs. If necessary, this can be handed to a member of staff in a named container at departure.
- Face masks
- Small bottle of hand sanitiser

Other items:

- Cameras these are costly and don't like water! I suggest a disposable one or, even better, a **disposable waterproof one**
- Students may bring a small amount of spending money with them. No more than £20.

Camp Charter

Key Rules for the Ultimate Adventure Centre residential:

1 Children must not bring items such as: matches, electrical items including phones, music players, games consoles, tablet devices, jewellery, chewing gum or fizzy drinks.

2 Children must not bring or use mobile phones on the premises.

3 Children must only enter his or her own lodge or cabin.

4 Children must respect each other and adults and be polite to everyone else at the centre.

5 Children must respect each other's property and the centre's property

6 Children must follow all instructions given by adults

7 Children must not use any anti-social behaviour (for example: fighting, pushing, kicking, name-calling, offensive language, disrupting activities or people's free time, insulting people, vandalism, etc.)

8 Children must not leave the centre unsupervised.

9 Children are not allowed in other schools' allocated areas.
