

Preparing for a safe return to Simonside Primary School

A Summary for Parents/Carers

September 2020

We are delighted that we will be able to welcome all of our children and families (old and new) to Simonside this September, however, we understand that this may be a worrying time for many of you.

Please be assured that the safety of our children, staff and school community is our top priority and we are determined to open fully, as safely as possible, by implementing the following key measures that will limit the risk of virus transmission within our school:

- A one-way system is in place throughout the school site
- Staggered start/finish times
- Drop off and collection points staggered around the site
- Staggered break and lunch times
- Keeping children in class/year group 'bubbles' that do not mix with other bubbles in school
- Consistent staffing (as far as possible) within each bubble
- Children will be encouraged to socially distance (where possible and age appropriate)
- Tables will be positioned so that children sit side by side and do not face each other
- Children will be provided with their own pack of resources to use in lessons
- Windows will be open to increase ventilation in indoor spaces
- Increased outdoor learning opportunities
- Enhanced cleaning throughout the day, particularly frequently touched surfaces
- Increased hand washing throughout the day
- Hand sanitising stations in every classroom and additional stations elsewhere in school
- Ensure good respiratory hygiene by promoting the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach, and providing a plentiful supply of tissues and lidded bins throughout school
- Minimising transfer by requiring children to leave all items at home except for a named water bottle, book bag, wipeable packed lunch box (where required) and iPad (if part of the 1:1 programme in Years 3 & 4)
- · Visitors to school will be limited to essential visitors only
- No Breakfast Club provision until further notice (to prevent bubbles from mixing)

#### How can Parents/Carers support us to protect our school community?

- Follow government advice outside of school to avoid bringing the virus into school
- Follow the instructions of school staff at all times this is for the safety of everyone
- Please arrive promptly for drop off and collection (no more than 5 minutes before your child's start/finish time)
- Follow the one-way system at all times
- Remain socially distanced from other households and school staff
- Drop off and collection of children is limited to one adult per household
- Leave the school site immediately once children are dropped off / collected
- Do not send your child to school if they, or anyone in your household has symptoms of Coronavirus or if they have been told to isolate by test and trace inform school as soon as possible
- Get your child and household tested if they develop symptoms of Coronavirus
- If you would like to speak to a member of staff, please contact them via telephone, Seesaw or the school Facebook / Twitter pages
- Please be patient if things take a little longer than usual everyone will be doing the best they can to ensure your children are as safe as possible

#### Other points:

- School uniform should be worn (it is recommended that this is removed as soon as children arrive home and washed before it is next worn, if possible)
- Children should wear their outdoor school PE kit to school on PE days your child's class teacher will let you know which day this is required
- We have created some 'quick-view' posters, which can be found at the end of this booklet. We will be displaying these around school please spend a few moments familiarising yourself and your children with these

Please help us to keep our children, staff and community as safe as possible by following the guidance issued by school and the government; it's really important that we all work together to control the spread of Coronavirus.

Your support for a safe return to school is vital. Thank you.
