To support this journey and in order to add capacity we are looking to appoint teachers who have the experience and skills to teach across a range of subjects.

Cambridge Park Academy is part of the Humber Education Trust (HET), this Trust consists of 12 Primary schools and 4 Special Schools. Cambridge Park joined HET in April 2020. The relationship with HET is both supportive and collaborative, enabling curriculum development and improvement in outcomes for students.

If you are a colleague with a successful record of outstanding teaching, then this teaching role offers an opportunity to challenge yourself in a new environment. Highly motivated and driven applicants should have the creativity and vision to inspire and support change with a focus on ensuring successful outcomes.
