

Referral received from School or Early Years

EY referrals received From EY's Panel - Child under school age

Schools can refer directly to SLD Outreach - Children F2 and above

Referral logged and passed to either Tweendykes or Ganton Outreach Practitioner (OP)

Setting contacted to book in Initial Assessment (within 6 weeks of receiving referral)

Initial assessment Observation

Referral not accepted

Feedback provided to setting and EY informed

Referral accepted

Initial report submitted to setting and support plan provided.

Allocated 1-1 KW

May include:

- Intensive in setting support
- Coaching and modelling in setting
- Resource provision/loan
- Attendance at My Support Plan, PCP, TAF, Review meetings (if requested)

Referral accepted.

Training & development programme implemented.

May include:

- Whole team training
- Visits to special school setting

Review termly

Provide reports / update supports – setting

Update impact of support – EY

Discharge

- Child or setting no longer needing active support
- Child requires alternative outreach service – referral made
- Discharge report

Ongoing

- Review service support – possible advice only recommended
- Objectives met, reassess and new plan implemented
- No progress – reassess and either refer to other service, new plan implemented or refer back to EY team

Transition

- Child transitioning to different educational setting.
- Attend meeting (if requested)
- Inform future setting of involvement in advance to continue support if required
