## **Online Learning**

Within the first few weeks of September, you will receive a copy of login details to your child's account for the Apps we use in school.

The children will be introduced to some of these Apps as they move into Year 1. This will all be new to them but we will support your child at school with these and we would greatly appreciate your support at home.

The Apps include **Times Tables Rockstars, PurpleMash & Mathletics.**

We will be looking out for who uses these Apps at home and rewards will be given throughout the year.

## **Home Reading:**

Please listen to your child read their school reading book as often as you can, even if it is just for 10 minutes at a time.

We use the RWI Reading Scheme (Read, Write Inc.) within our school. Your child will come home with a RWI book to share/read at home. New books will be given out weekly on a Friday along with homework.

## **Homework:**

Throughout the year, your child will receive a combination of homework developing their knowledge and skills in Reading, Spelling, Maths and Grammar.

Your child will have a homework folder that they will bring home on a Friday and it must be returned with the completed work on Tuesday of the following week.

A copy of the weekly spellings will also be included within the homework folder on a Friday and the children will be tested the following Friday.

## Year 1 General Information

- PE will be on a **Monday afternoon**. Please ensure your child comes to school dressed in their PE kits on this day. Visit <http://www.stanhopeprimary.com> for a full list of kits.
- Any letters or reply slips, which need to be returned, can be given to your child to hand in to the Year 1 staff. Any money will need to be labelled clearly inside an envelope before handing it in.
- We have healthy tuck shop which will take place every **Wednesday**. The children can buy up to 3 items, so a maximum of £1 is needed. Money can be brought into class in advance for future weeks and will be kept in your child's envelope.
- It is a fact that drinking water throughout the day helps improve concentration levels. Please send your child to school with an appropriate water bottle every day, again clearly labelled.

### **PLEASE NOTE:**

Your child **IS NOT** required to bring in any stationary from home. Everything will be provided by the school. Please leave personal items at home. Thank you.
