Online Learning

Please use the **Myon App** from **Accelerated Reader & Times Tables Rockstars App** regularly at home.

Work for all Y6 pupils will be set on each App for the entire school year, this means that they can work through it at their own pace.

In Y6 we award monthly prizes for those pupils who impress us most on each of the Apps.

All passwords and usernames will be sent out to you in September.

Home Reading

Please listen to your child read their school reading book as often as you can, every day is ideal, even if it is just for 10 minutes. **Our expectation is that their reading book will be changed every week.**

As soon as your child has finished their book, return it to school in exchange for a new book.

General Information

Homework: Throughout the year, your child will receive a combination of homework developing their knowledge and skills in Reading, Spelling, Maths and Grammar. Your child will have a homework folder that they will bring home daily and must be returned with the completed work on the specified days.

Year 6 Weekly Timetable:

Monday: Reading Comprehension homework is given out and is to be returned on a Friday.

Arithmetic test is completed weekly.

Tuesday: P.E. with Mr Rogers.

Wednesday: P.E. with Mrs Conway (Active Kids).

(Please make sure your child has the correct School PE Kit and trainers on both days).

Maths homework is given out and to be returned on a Monday.

Times Tables test is completed weekly.

Thursday: Spelling test carried out weekly.

Spellings for the following week are given out.

SATs Information

The SATs are expected to take place on the week beginning **Monday 8th May 2023**. We ask parents not to remove children from school before the SATs as this time is spent helping the children prepare and revise so they feel they are ready to give their best.

Everyday within Year 6, during break and lunch time **booster groups** will take place, in order to help and support your child with their English and Maths skills in small group situations, which is highly beneficial.

In Year 6, there is an expectation that pupils will take on an increased workload from **January** in preparation for their SATs. Therefore, children will be given daily booster homework (in the form of their own Reading, Maths and Grammar Revision Guides), which must be returned to school the following day.

In the forthcoming months we will be hosting a SATs information meeting in the school hall, please make every effort to attend.
