## Online Learning

Please use the **myON and Times Tables Rockstars Apps** regularly at home to practise reading and tables.

Work for all Y3 pupils will be accessible on these apps every week.

All passwords and usernames will be sent out to you in September.

## Home Reading

Please listen to your child read their school reading book or a chosen book as often as you can, every day is ideal, even if it is just for 10 minutes. Our expectation is that their reading book will be changed every week (twice a week if possible.)

As soon as your child has finished their book, return it to school in exchange for a new book.

## General Information

**Homework:** Throughout the year, your child will receive a combination of homework developing their knowledge and skills in reading, writing, spelling, maths and grammar. Your child will have a homework folder that they will bring home weekly and it must be returned with the completed work on the specified days. Please support your child in making sure this is completed each week. Homework reinforces prior learning and will increase throughout KS2 so getting into a routine will prepare your child in the future.

### Year 3 Weekly Timetable – Key days:

**Monday:** Homework will be given out in homework folders to be returned on Thursday morning.

**Wednesday:** Tuck shop (items are 30p each)

**Thursday:** Return homework to Mrs Barnes.

P.E day – come to school in P.E kit.

**Friday:** Miss Corr will be teaching you on a Friday. Spellings will be given out and spelling test carried out today (Friday).

\*\*Reading books will be changed when returned.

## Key Information

There is a transition from Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 2 and changes to the daily routine. We will support your child with this and make sure they are settled and happy and know the timetable of lessons for each day.

Interventions will take place during the academic year in order to help and support your child with their English and Maths skills in small groups. This is highly beneficial and will support gaps in your child's learning. These usually take place at lunchtimes and during assembly.

If homework is not handed in in line with our home/school agreement policy children will complete it in school each week on a Friday morning during break time.

If you feel your child needs extra social or emotional support after the uncertain times we have all experienced recently, Mrs Davison our Social/Emotional lead is available to speak to if you have any concerns at all about your child's well-being.
