We are all really excited for you to start, this brand new year at school. We hope that you have had a fantastic summer and you are all ready to start your learning journey once again.

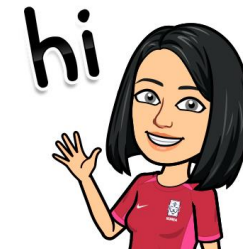
We know that you may be feeling nervous and worried about starting a new year, this is very normal. We are here to support you in achieving your goals and being successful.

### Home Reading

Please listen to your child read their school reading book as often as you can. Every day is ideal, even if it is just for 10 minutes. Our expectation is that their reading book will be changed **every week**. Your child may come home with two reading books in one week – this is good practice, as we will be sharing one during our Guided Reading sessions and the children will work through one daily during RWI.

Reading books will be **sent home on a Friday** and will be expected to be **returned no later than a Tuesday**.

### Online Learning

Please use the **Reading Bugs, Letter Join & Times Tables Rockstars App** regularly at home.

Work for all Y2 pupils will be set on each App for the entire term. This means that the children can work through it at their own pace.

In Y2, we award monthly prizes for those pupils who impress us most on each of the Apps.

All passwords and usernames will be sent home week commencing 16<sup>th</sup> September 2024.

### General Information

**Homework:** Throughout the year, your child will receive a combination of homework developing their knowledge and skills in Reading, Spelling, Maths and Grammar. Your child will have a homework folder that they will bring home on a Friday and must be returned with the completed work on a Tuesday at the latest.

#### Year 2 Weekly Timetable:

Monday: Spellings given out.

Tuesday: Homework including reading books returned to school.

Thursday: Tuck Shop- Money to school, P.E

Friday: Homework and reading books sent home. Spelling test in school.

### SATs Information
