## General Information

### Homework:

Throughout the year, your child will receive a combination of homework developing their knowledge and skills in Reading, Spelling, Maths and Grammar. Your child will have a homework book and bag that they will bring home weekly and must be returned with the completed work on the specified days.

### Year 3 Weekly Timetable:

Trips and outings- all trips and outings will be posted onto Parentpay, please ensure you check regularly.

## Important information for home-learning:

The importance of reading at home cannot be taken lightly. We expect adults to listen to children reading at least once per week and to make a comment in the reading diary they will be given. Children should also read on a daily basis for 10 minutes. This can be to an adult or alone.

Homework is set with the intention that children will complete it as independently as possible. They are also expected to bring it back to school promptly and complete. The tasks set are chosen to be things they have already covered in class and children MUST attempt the work. We encourage children who are struggling to come and speak to a teacher.
