Online Learning

Please use the **Reading Bugs** and **Times Tables Rockstars App** regularly at home.

All passwords and usernames will be sent out to you in September.

Home Reading

Please listen to your child read their school reading book or a chosen book as often as you can, every day is ideal, even if it is just for 10 minutes. Our expectation is that their reading book will be changed every week (twice a week if possible.) If you read with your child 4 times a week and sign their reading record they will receive a raffle ticket and be entered into a prize draw.

Reading records and books need to come into school every day. As soon as your child has finished their book, return it to school in exchange for a new book.

General Information

Homework: Throughout the year, your child will receive a combination of homework developing their knowledge and skills in reading, writing, spelling, maths and grammar. Your child will have a homework book that they will bring home weekly and it must be returned with the completed work on the specified days. Please support your child in making sure this is completed each week.

Year 5 Weekly Timetable:

Monday: P.E day – come to school in P.E kit (from September until December then this will change to a Tuesday and Wednesday after Christmas). Spellings handed out.

Tuesday: Swimming day- From September until December- Normal school uniform to be worn. Return homework to Mrs Dunn.

Wednesday: Tuck shop, children can buy up to 3 items so a maximum of £1.50 is needed.

Friday: Weekly spelling test. Homework will be given out. Homework to be returned Tuesday.

****Reading books must be brought into school every day along with reading record.**

Key Information

Interventions will take place during the academic year in order to help and support your child with their English and Maths skills in small groups. This is highly beneficial and will support gaps in your child's learning. These usually take place at break times/lunchtimes and during assembly.

If homework is not handed in, in line with our home/school agreement policy, children will complete it in school each week on a Tuesday morning during break time.
