

Pupil Premium

Pupil premium is allocated to children whose parents are currently serving in the armed forces, children of statutory school age from low-income families who are known to be eligible for Free School Meals, children looked after continuously for more than 6 months and Free School Meals children in non-mainstream settings. Schools are allocated additional funding to be used to support interventions and provision already in place at their schools or to provide extra provision where a need is apparent.

Biddick Hall Juniors received £184'660 to help support our most disadvantaged children in the following ways:

- employment of additional teaching staff to reduce class size and support pupil premium children so that outstanding progress continues to be achieved
- Increase the number of PP children achieving GDS in reading and maths
- purchase of additional resources in literacy and numeracy
- to provide extra support via teaching assistants within the classroom and the playgrounds. This additional support will be used for social and emotional needs as well as learning needs and transition, to ensure that the children are ready to learn and are given every opportunity to fulfil their potential
- to subsidise educational visits and after-school activities
