ATTENDANCE.

HOME LEARNING DURING COVID-19.

If your child needs to self-isolate because they test positive or they live with someone who has tested positive, then home learning will be provided. GOOGLE CLASSROOM

Children have been practising how to access Google Classroom in school. Please remember that you need to go to the school website FIRST to log in to your SCHOOL google account.

The user name is their first name and initial of their last name, all lower case with no spaces or dots. The password has to have 8 characters.
