Autumn Term Events

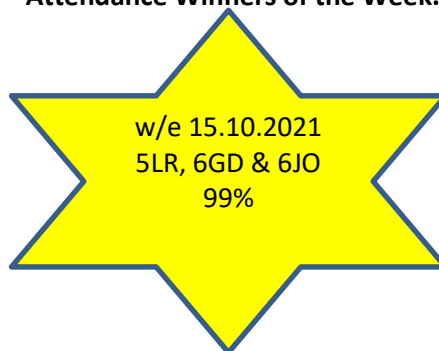
w/c 13.9.21	Year 6 start swimming lessons
