# ATTENDANCE.



## HOME LEARNING

Any child self-isolating will be expected to complete home learning.

All work for the day is uploaded on Google Classroom by the class teacher and <u>must</u> be completed.

Teachers are also delivering some live teaching to pupils at home on a daily basis. Pupils can access support from their teachers by clicking on the meeting link, even if live teaching is not going ahead. The meet link is kept open for much of the day. It is better to contact the teacher via the meet link for immediate feedback.

It is useful to have the worksheet open when completing a live lesson so pupils can access the worksheet easily if need be.

If there are any issues, then please don't hesitate to contact school and ask for help. Please email **admin@biddickhallschool.co.uk** if you test positive over a weekend or holiday. If you have any COVID symptoms or test positive on a LFT you MUST take a confirmatory PCR test.

# CHANGES TO THE SELF-ISOLATION PERIOD FOR THOSE WHO TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID 19

From Monday 17 January, people who are self-isolating with COVID-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day 5 and day 6 and they do not have a temperature. For example,

if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to their education or childcare setting immediately on day 6.

The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. All test results should be reported to NHS Test and Trace.

If the result of either of their tests is positive, they should continue to self-isolate until they get negative results from two LFD tests on consecutive days or until they have completed 10 full days of self-isolation, whichever is earliest.

Anyone who is unable to take LFD tests or anyone who continues to have a temperature will need to complete the full 10 day period of self-isolation.
