Coming to school is important. Each week we will award a certificate to the class with the best attendance.

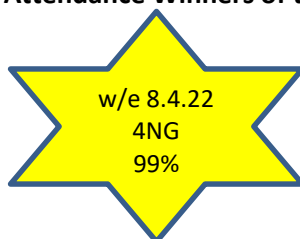
You must ring school and inform school on the first day of absence.
