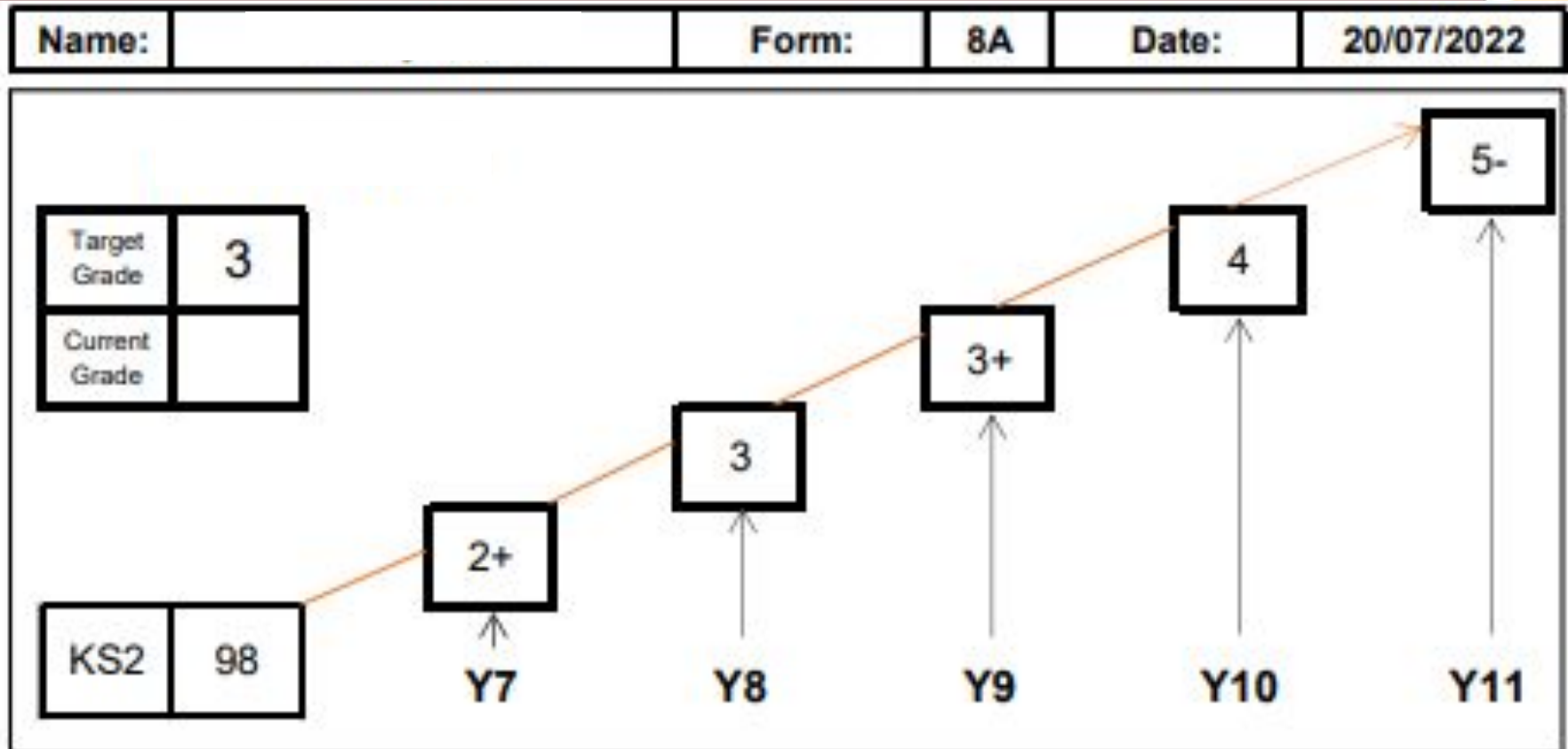

Google Classroom



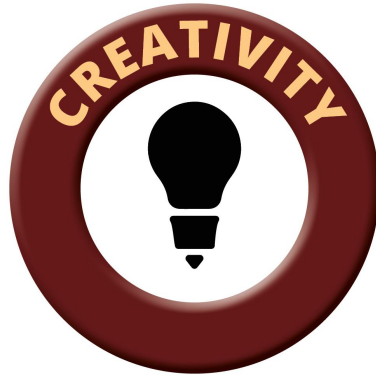
By clicking here, a student can “join” the lesson if they are working elsewhere in the school.

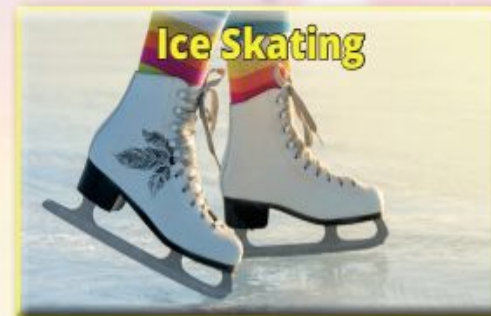
