

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<u>Programmes of study / Development Matters</u>

C&L

Communication and Language work is woven throughout the curriculum and daily practice. Contact and skills coverage is child dependent and therefore varies dependent on the child's current level of development

EAD

- Explore, use and refine a variety of artistic effects to express their ideas and feelings
- Sing in a group or on their own, increasingly matching the pitch and following the melody
- Develop story lines in pretend play
- Explore and engage in music making and dance, performing solo or in groups

UW

- Show interest in different occupations
- Explore and talk about different forces they can feel
- Talk about the differences between materials and changes they notice
- Explore how things work

PD

- Use core muscles to achieve good posture when sitting at a table or on the floor.
- Confidently and safely use a range of small and large apparatus indoors and outdoors.
 Know and talk about different factors that support wellbeing e.g. brushing teeth, being a safe pedestrian.
- Learn how to form all letters in the alphabet and develop foundations of a handwriting style which is fast, accurate and efficient.
- Use core muscles to achieve good posture when sitting at a table or on the floor.

PSED

- Develop appropriate ways of being assertive.
- Build confidence in new social situations and become more outgoing with unfamiliar people.
- Become more outgoing with unfamiliar people, in the safe context of their setting.
- Begin to understand how others might be feeling.
