Understanding of the World

- ✓ Describe their immediate environment using knowledge from observation, discussion, stories, non-fiction texts and maps.
- Explain some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries, drawing on knowledge from stories from stories, non-fiction texts and-when appropriate-maps.
- Understand the past through settings, characters and events encountered in books read in class and storytelling.
- ✓ Explore the natural world around them.

<u>Literacy</u>

- Demonstrate understanding of what has been read to them by retelling stories and narratives using their own words and recently introduced vocabulary.
- Engage in role play areas and story telling.
- Use and understand recently introduced vocabulary during role play.
