# External Grants & Match Funding

We work hard to look for external funding and have been successful in several last year!

The Cleadon District Rotary Club granted us just under £1000 which paid the difference from what we had fundraised for in 20/21 and allowed us to purchase the defibrilator sited outside the Infant School. They also funded a large donation towards the Juniors Book Vending Machine.

We've also been successful in two £500 grants from Asda, one of which part paid the Winter Warmer firepit sessions for all the children and kept costs to parents low.

We have also been lucky enough to receive match funding payments, where a parent works for a firm who offers this. Please please please check with your employer to see if they run this scheme, as its an easy way to hoost our funds.

### Sports Day Tuck Shop & Tombola

Sports Day was a bit different this year, and the weather changed it further.

At the Infants we ran our Tombola (which we had been due to run at the Juniors Picnic which was cancelled). This raised us £253 and lots of people left happy, clinking as they went with wine bottles.

At the Juniors we attended with our tuck shop, with drinks and cake. It was quieter this year, possibly because it was in the afternoon, but still worth us coming along, raising £250.

#### **Xmas Stocking Fillers**

Last year our committee were hard at work, like little Xmas elves. We produced and sold Xmas bracelets, Reindeer hot choc and Santa marshmallow cones, chocolate stirrers and reindeer dust.

This contributed just under £590 to this years fundraising, and hopefully brought some smiles to our pupils faces on Xmas Eve & Day.

Everything we do wouldn't be possible without the support of all school staff, which includes the office staff. kitchen staff and even the old caretaker from the Juniors (DJ Windle is much loved by the children at the discos!) and of course all the parents and family members on the committee.
