I know that he was born in 673 and taken to a monastery at the age of 7. I know how Bede was a great writer and one of the greatest teachers of the Early Middle Ages. I know how he wrote biographies, Latin hymns, poetry and books designed to teach Latin to monks. I know how Bede used the term anno domini or AD to show the dates after Christ and it is because of Venerable Bede that we still often use this method today. I know how The Venerable Bede was a scientist and he worked out how the moon affected the tides and he believed the world was round - a major achievement for the time. I know that The Venerable Bede died in 735 and he was buried in Jarrow which is close to our school. I know how he was made a Saint in 1899.
