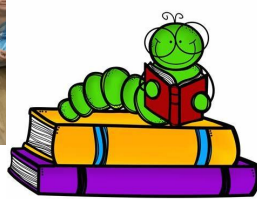
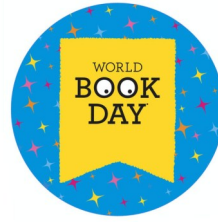


World Book Day 2025!
