


<p>Choose a book from home, or think of a story from school you like. Choose a character and draw them. Think of adjectives to describe what they are like (what do they look like, what kind of person are they?).</p> <p>Purple Mash 2do set. You are the author, use your imagination! Remember we innovate stories all the time in school you can do this!</p>	<p>Type this into your web browser. https://nrich.maths.org/136</p> <p>The problem is:</p> <p>Noah saw 12 legs walk by into the Ark. How many creatures did he see? Which creatures could they have been?</p>  <p>Draw your response on paper or draw the animals into your purple mash 2do. Purple Mash 2do set.</p>	<p>WHOLE SCHOOL</p> <p>I love my family because...</p> <p>Draw a picture of your family. Write about why you are grateful for them. You could add this to your window next to your rainbow from last week.</p>
<p>Read these words. Fruit, group, blue, balloon, tune, huge and blew. Remember to say the sounds as you read the word! How do you spell /oo/ in these words? Write them into categories on a piece of paper on how you spell /oo/. Say the sounds as you write the words.</p>	<p>Make an A - Z list down your page - and write the word SPRING at the top. Now can you think of a word that begins with each letter on your page? For example...</p> <p>A - April B - Blossom C - Crocus CHALLENGE! What about Z? Good luck!!</p>		<p>R.E. week Watch the video about Easter time on espresso. (KS1-RE-Easter) Now open your purple mash 2do to type up your 'Easter Research' Purple Mash 2do Set If you don't have a computer you could draw a mind map about what you have learned from watching the video.</p>

<p>Now choose the same character from above and draw and fill a speech bubble for what they say in the story. For example the giant in Jack and the Beanstalk “Fe Fi Fo Fum...” Or the wolf “Little pig, Little pig let me come in” etc. Purple Mash 2Do set. You can do this on paper if you don’t have an electronic device.</p>	<p>Parents: read this sentence to your child: The huge blue balloon blew in the sky. Ask your child to write this sentence and underline the different ways we spell /oo/. If your child misspells one of the words in bold. Help them to write it again correctly</p>	<p>Can you write out the facts in the 2, 5 and 10 times tables? You can do this on paper or on Purple Mash. Purple Mash 2do set. Now log in to espresso to check your knowledge. Play the games about groups of 2, 5 and 10. (KS1-Maths-Multiplication and Division-groups of 2, 5 and 10).</p>	<p>R.E. week Make a list of all the Christian celebrations, for example Christmas and Easter, what other celebrations are there? You may have been to one or two of them. Draw a picture to go with each one of them. Now choose a celebration that you have been to that is your favourite. Draw a picture and add a sentence explaining what is happening.</p>
