(be safety aware as they can be a choking hazard so must be supervised)</p> <p>Place coins under a piece of paper and make coin rubbing with a pencil or crayon.</p> <p>Place all of the coins on a plate and ask your child to look away. Remove a coin and ask your child to guess which one is missing.</p>	<p><b>Whole School</b> - How about trying one or more of these outdoor/garden activities with your adult? Which one do you fancy?
