

Remind them to use finger spaces, a capital letter and a full stop.</p>	<p><b>Addition and Subtraction.</b></p> <p>Read the following problems out loud to your child.</p> <p>'If Jack has 13 sweets and he gives 2 sweets to Emily how many sweets will Jack have left?'</p> <p>'Tom picks 14 strawberries. If Tom picks 5 more strawberries how many strawberries will he have all together?'</p> <p>'There are 8 dogs in a kennel. If 3 dogs run out of the kennel how many dogs will be left?'</p>	<p><b>Plants in the garden.</b></p> <p>This week we are learning all about plants. Whilst on a walk or in your garden have a look to see what different plants you can see. Can you name the plants? If you do not know the name of the plant you could try to research and find out the name of the plant you have found.</p> <p>Have a go at drawing and labelling some of the plants you have found on <b>Purple Mash</b>.
