**Paul went for a long walk in August.**


Ask your child to write these sentences one word at a time. Remind them to use finger spaces, a capital letter and a full stop.




**Multiplication & Division**

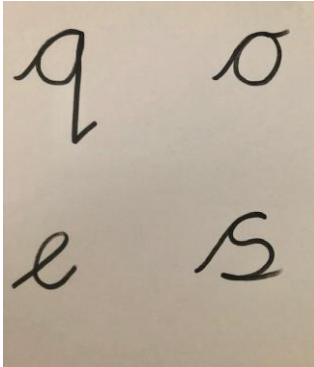
