## **Welcome Back**

### **Informal Childcare**

Could I remind you all of the current restrictions in terms of informal childcare. Two households should not be mixing unless this is to carry out an informal childcare arrangement.

Anyone who is collecting your child as part of an informal childcare arrangement should be included on our school records. Asking other adults to collect your child outside of this arrangement is against current regulations and should be avoided.

#### **School Lunches**

Our school catering team are currently doing an excellent job in ensuring school lunches are provided to children in such a way to avoid bubbles in school mixing with other bubbles.

This means that your child eats their lunch in the school hall one week then in their classroom the next. We have listened and responded to your concerns and now the takeaway meals which are serviced in classrooms each Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday will be a hot meal for example a pizza, burger, sausage in a bun etc.

Each Monday and Friday the classroom option will be a sandwich. On days when the takeaway menu is a sandwich there will always be either a cake or biscuit for dessert.

Meals served in the school hall will always be a hot meal served from the hatch. I do hope that you can appreciate the great effort that is being put in across the lunchtimes and continue to support the school with
