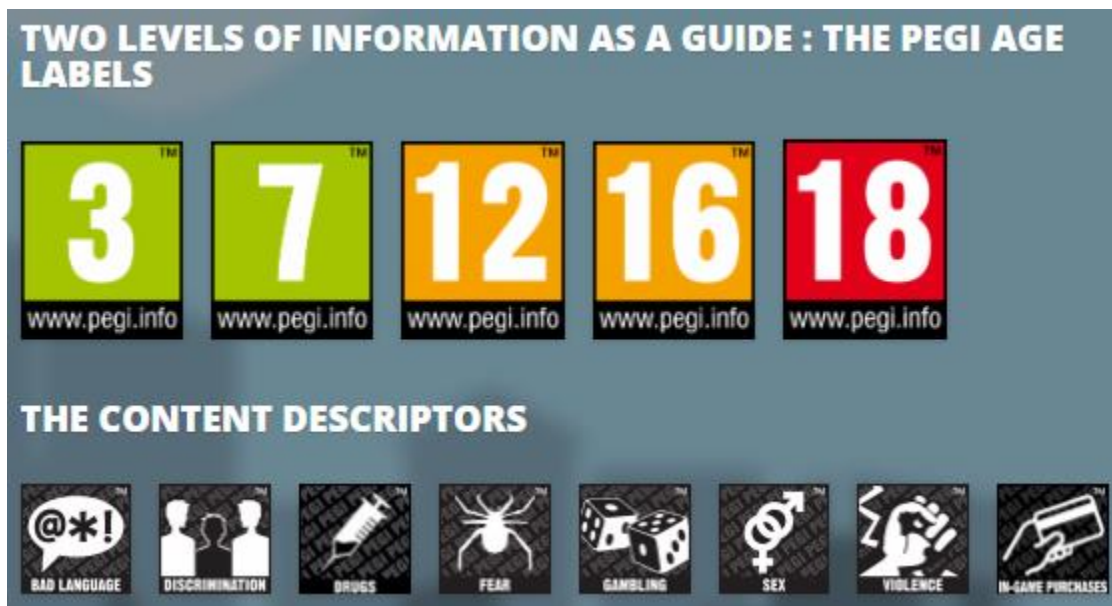




Dear Parents and Carers,

It is important that children are monitored and are only able to access content which is age appropriate. It is important that adults follow PEGI ratings which make clear the age the game is suitable for. Please be aware the games played by older children/adults in the home may not be suitable when younger children are present as even though they are not playing the game they may hear or see inappropriate content.

Many children have shared that they access Youtube, Kids Youtube and Tic Toc whilst at home. We recognise that these can be valuable applications for education and entertainment however again this must be monitored. Please take the time to review the security settings to ensure inappropriate content is filtered. It is important to note that even with the strictest restrictions some inappropriate content may still be accessible. With this in mind we ask adults to be vigilant when your child is online.
